The call for Marie Curie Fellowships will be published by the European Commission **on 18 March 2009** and indicates the deadline as **18 August 2009** (note this deadline is for the Commission. **Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna deadlines are much earlier**)

Potential applicants should **send their expression of interest** to the Lider-Lab **no later than 10 April 2009**

A Committee presided over by the Coordinator of the Lider-Lab will evaluate each expression of interest and decide whether to submit the proposal to the EC or not. All candidates will be informed of the result of this evaluation in due time before the deadline for submitting the applications to the Commission.

Note: the selection process involves **two steps**. A **first** selection will be made based on the **expression of interest (to be submitted by April 10)**. **Secondly**, those candidates chosen on the basis of their expression of interest will be invited to submit a **complete tentative proposal (by June 10)** for final evaluation prior to obtaining full support by our institution

The expressions of interest should include:

- a) the application form providing essential details
- b) a detailed CV including a list of publications
- c) a research proposal of two pages in length
- d) two letters of reference to be sent directly by the referees to the Lider-Lab (to: info@lider-lab.org)

Documents a-d should be submitted electronically to info@lider-lab.org by **April 10 2009**.
